Fire Safety Burn Ban In Effect
 The Thurston County Outdoor Burn Ban is effective as of 3 p.m., Thursday, June 24, 2021, and ending Thursday, September 30, 2021. The Fire Safety Burn Ban applies to residential yard waste burning and all land clearing burns. The use of charcoal briquettes, gas, and propane barbeques, as well as recreational fires on private residential properties are allowed. Recreational fires must be contained in approved concrete, stone or metal pits like those commonly found in campgrounds.

Clearwood is a NO FIREWORKS community.

Clearwood being a heavily wooded with heavy underbrush community; we must all take precautions and work together to keep our community safe.

If you see Firework use, please write and turn in a Violation.

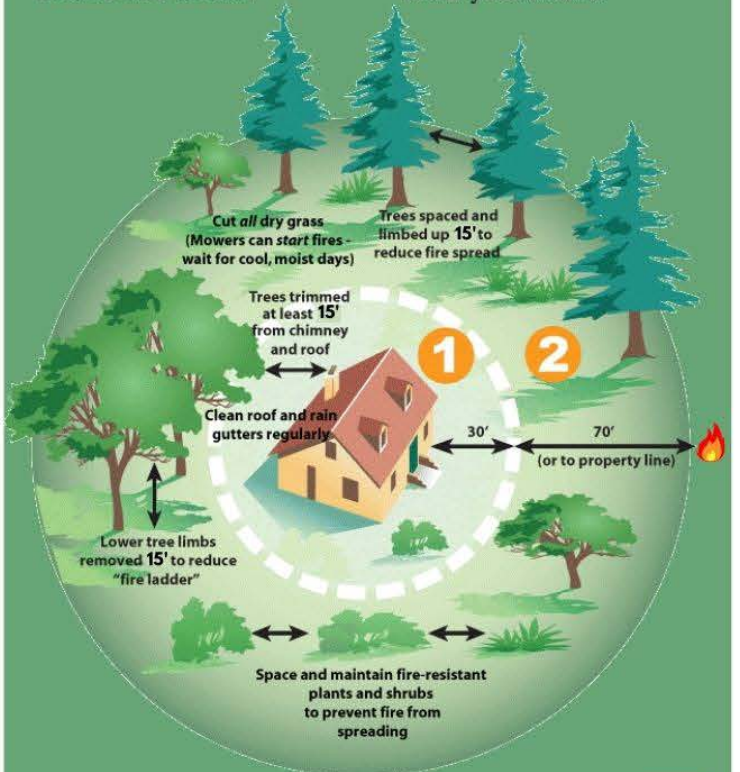


RED BOOK, G. MISCELLANEOUS REGULATIONS 1. Fires, Fire Pits and Putting Out Fires

- A person must be in attendance and a **CHARGED WATER HOSE MUST BE PRESENT** at the fire site whenever a fire is burning (day or night, any season, wet or dry).
- When the fire danger is **"HIGH"** either small fires only will be permitted in properly constructed fire pits (designs are available at the office) or a **TOTAL BURNING BAN** will be established.

| <p>30 Feet</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Trees trimmed at least <u>15 feet</u> from chimney and roof. • Clear vegetation <u>10 feet</u> around propane tanks. • Keep lawns mowed. • Prune low tree branches <u>15 feet</u> above ground to reduce fire ladder. | <p>70 Feet</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Trees spaced <u>15 feet</u> and limbed 10 feet to reduce fire spread. • Cut all dry grass (Mowers can start fires -- wait for cool, moist days) • Stack firewood at least <u>100 feet</u> away and uphill from your home. |
