- The concrete at the pool that was rejected was removed and repoured.
- The Pool has been fully staffed even though nationally there has been a lifeguard staffing crisis.
- The pool opened successfully on June 25th.
- The lake beaches were treated on 06/08/2022 for aquatic weeds.
- I have been in contact with the Sherriff's department on the embezzlement case.
- I have been in contact with the Sherriff's department about a contract for extra duty patrol, they are not signing any contracts at this time.
- I have been in contact with the Postal service about the repair that needs done at Blue lake court mailboxes <u>and</u> the replacement of *their* lock at all mailbox locations in Clearwood. As a reminder for folks this is *not* a lock that we can replace. There is no estimated date for the Clearwood locks to be replaced.
- Operations has seen a significant impact this month due to illness.
- The Pickleball courts project is well underway.
- One of the last remaining houses that was in foreclosure and in extreme disrepair recently sold and was fixed and is back on the market.
- Well 5 has made more progress this month. We are on budget and on schedule.
- 107 homes have sold in 2022
- We are scheduling our next water repair for the beginning of July.
- Our water leakage is at 43% as of the end of March we will calculate at the end of June for this quarter.
- Water bills and renter fees will be invoiced this week and mailed out to Members.
- We had a bus hit one of our gates a couple months ago the insurance claim has been filed and we are waiting on parts from the gate company.
- The capital request was approved for the exit laser for the motorcycles, that part is on order with the gate company and will be installed once it gets in.
- We have started budget planning for 2023 Jennifer will be here on the 29th for a whole day of budget planning.
- Collections are at 74% for the month of May.
